Various online competitions were held during the entire academic year such as poster Making, Ad Mad Show, Rangoli, Best out of waste, and so on.



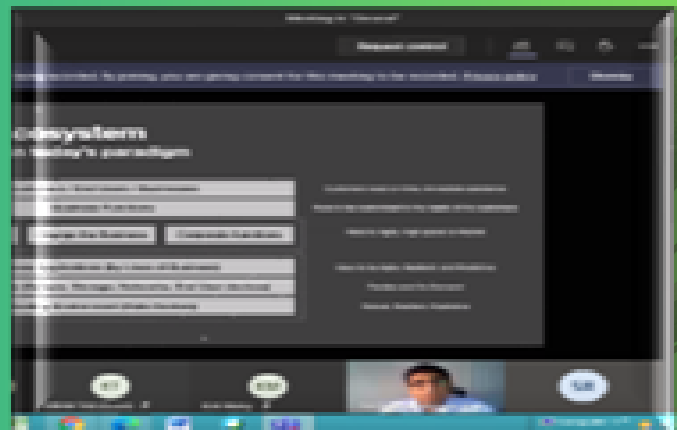
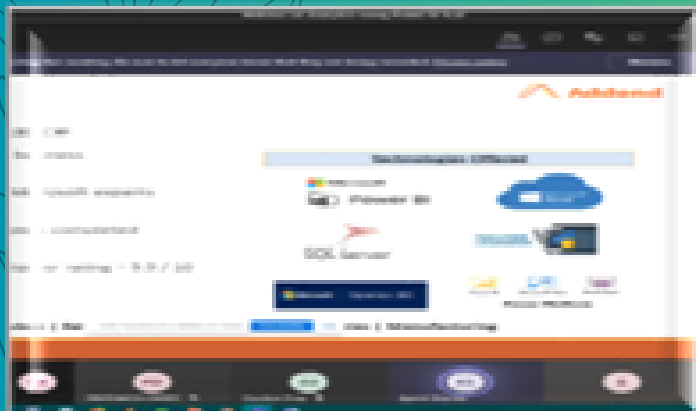
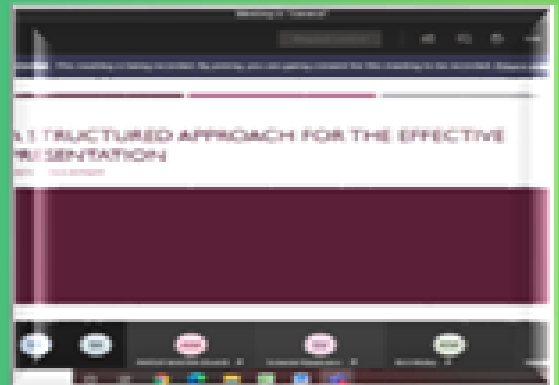
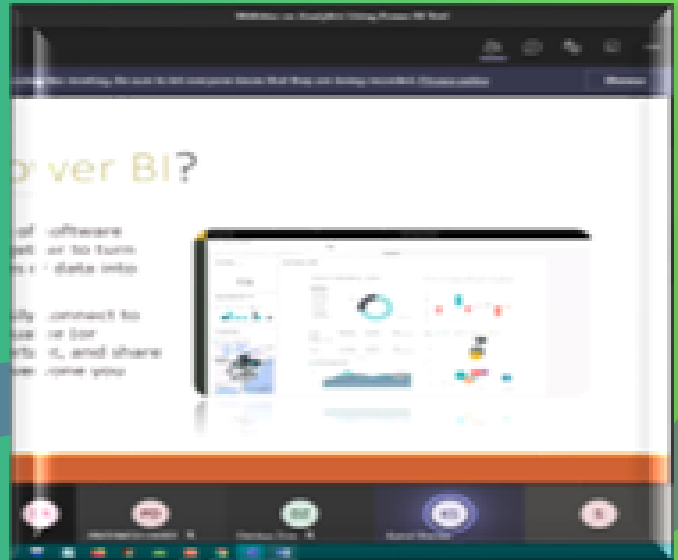
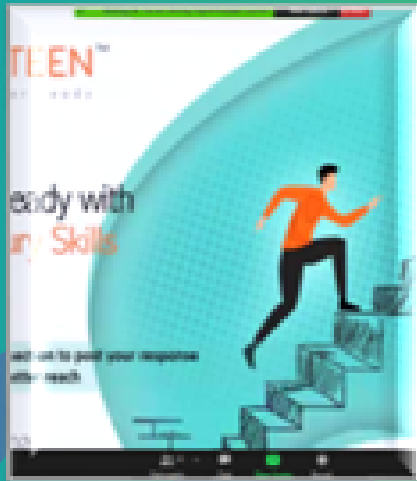
Orientation
