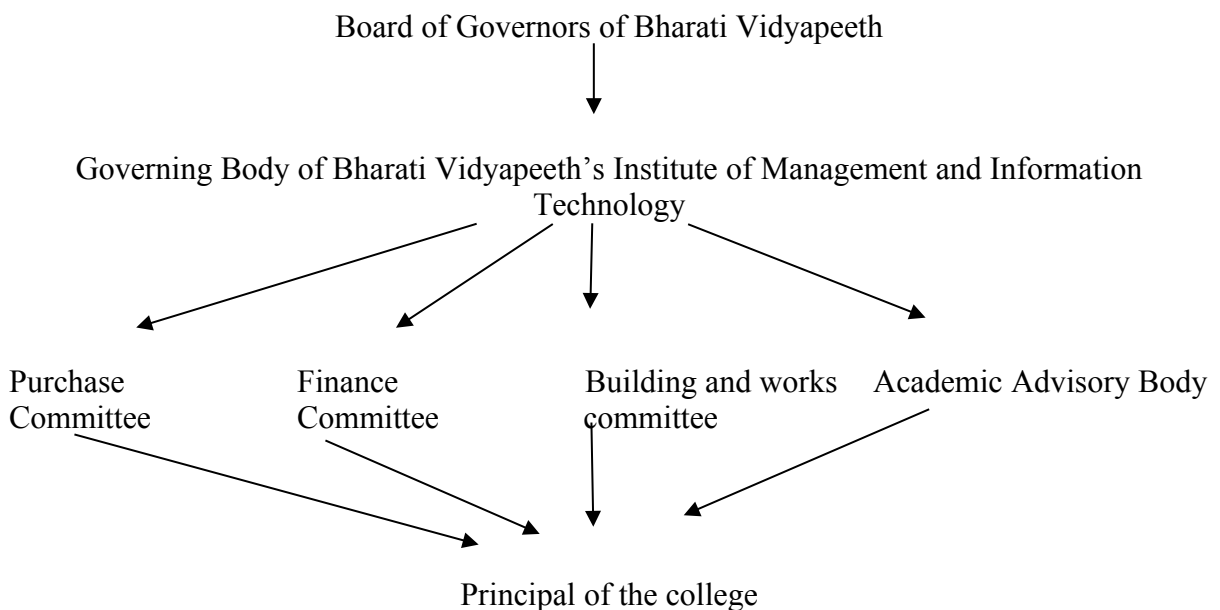

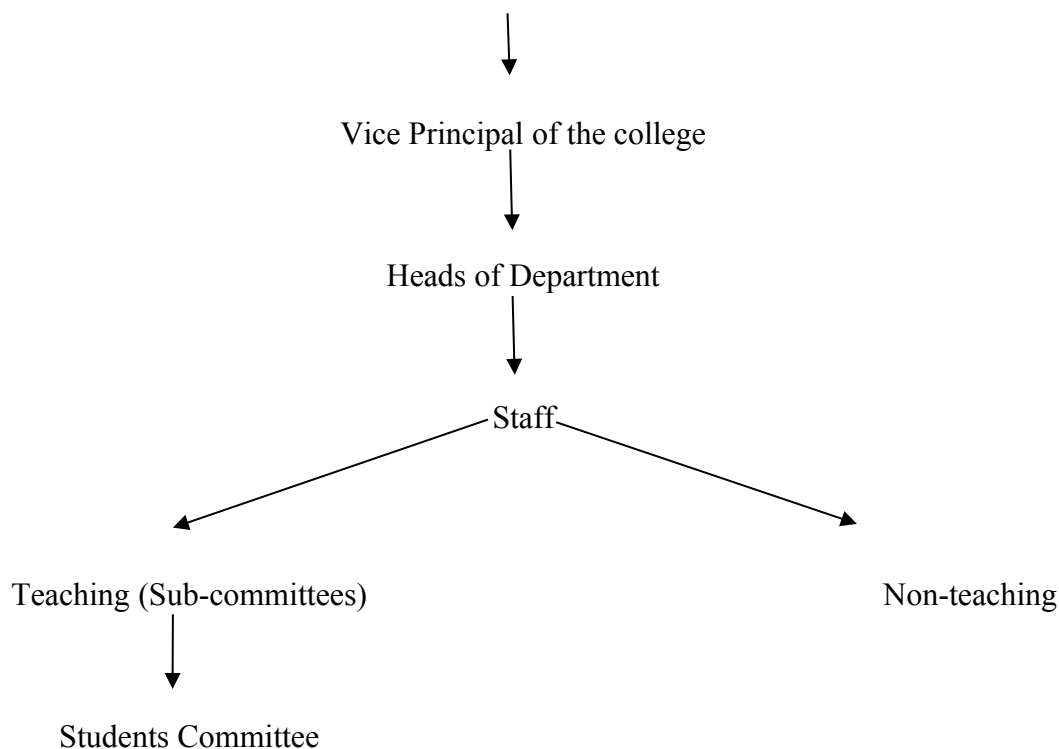

- **Criteria with its respective weightages i.e. Admission Test, marks in qualifying examination**

Total marks secured by the candidate in the subject Computer, Mathematics, General knowledge out of 200 marks in MHT-CET examination are considered for deciding the merit of the candidate. In case of a tie the marks secured by the candidate in the subject of Gradation.

- **Minimum level of acceptance:**

Only students who have appeared for the MHT-CET examination are eligible for admission to MCA. Course. The minimum eligibility criteria for appearing for MHT-CET examination and hence admission to the MCA. Program is as follows :

- Candidate should have Passing Minimum of 50 % in aggregate. (45% Backwards Class)
- The candidate should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects Mathematics/Statistics.
